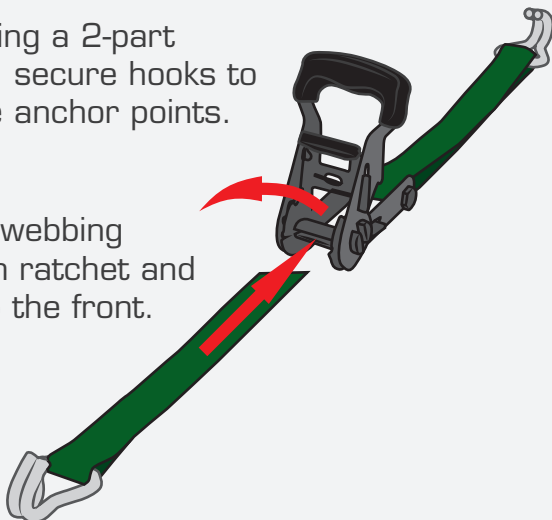


KNOW-HOW: RATCHET LASHINGS

1. If using a 2-part lashing, secure hooks to suitable anchor points.

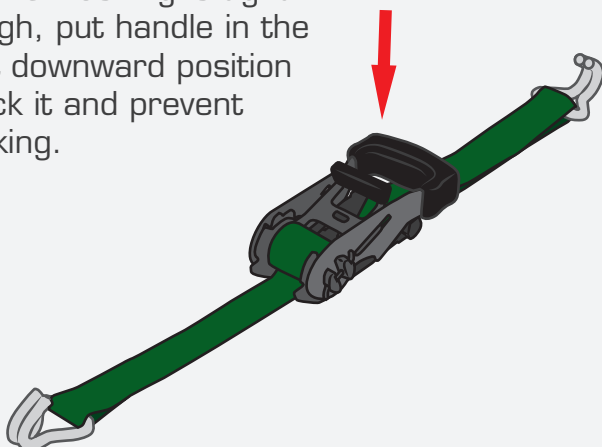
2. Pull webbing through ratchet and back to the front.



3. Move handle back and forth to tighten lashing.



4. When lashing is tight enough, put handle in the most downward position to lock it and prevent breaking.



5. To release lashing, first bring the handle to an upwards position, then pull the safety catch and bring the handle all the way down.



6. Push inner safety catch backward, while at the same time pulling webbing out of the ratchet.
